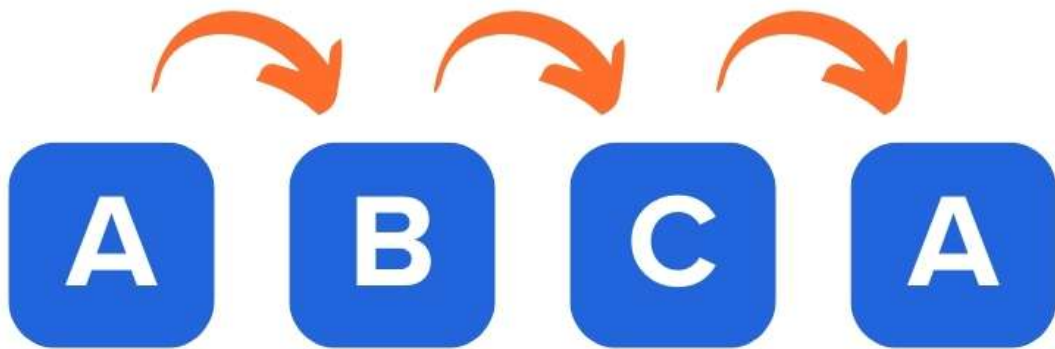


Redirect Loops



A redirect loop is when a URL keeps redirecting back to itself or in **circles**.

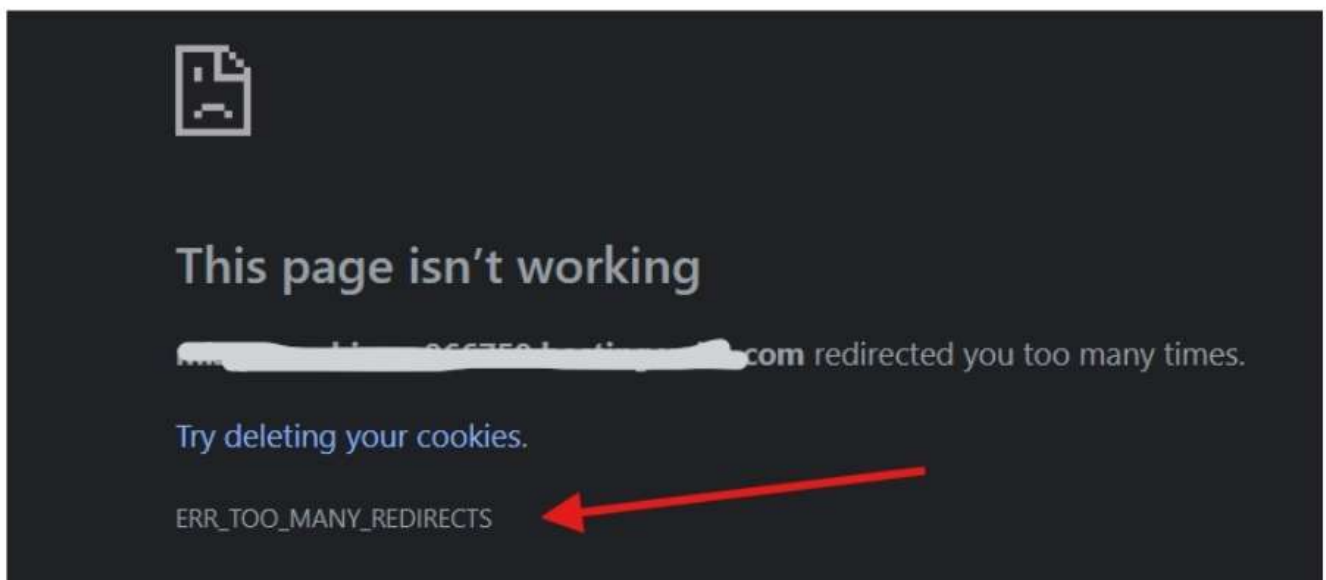
For Example: A → B → C → A

Page A is going through multiple URLs before circling back to A.

The loop **never ends**. Page never loads.

Why it's a Problem

- Page **won't load**
- Users see **erros**
- Wastes **crawl budget**
- Search engines **can't crawl**
- Kills **rankings**



Fix



- First find out the final URL destination that you want.
 - Make sure each URL points to a final, unique destination and **not back to itself** or another in the loop.
 - In this Example: A → D
 - If the final destination is C then redirect A to C.
- ✔ Break the loop.
