


Redirect Loops



A redirect loop is when a URL keeps redirecting back to itself or in circles.

For Example: $A \rightarrow B \rightarrow C \rightarrow A$


Page A is going through multiple URLs before circling back to A.

The loop never ends. Page never loads.



Why it's a Problem

- Page won't load
- Users see erros
- Wastes crawl budget
- Search engines can't crawl
- Kills rankings





Fix



- First find out the final URL destination that you want.
- Make sure each URL points to a final, unique destination and not back to itself or another in the loop.
- In this Example: A → D
- If the final destination is C then redirect A to C.
- Break the loop.
